3.3. Is the certificate the same document as COIDA?

**TASEZ Answer: No** 

- 3.4. Under key personnel experience, bidders with electrical engineering degrees mustn't submit a trade certificate, however they should submit ECSA accreditation.
- 3.5. Bidders won't lose points if they submit a N3, Trade Certificate and Wireman's license.
- 3.6. The end-user mentioned that bidder should also prepare a baseline risk assessment detailing all the risk associated with the project and mitigations and put it on a spreadsheet that will talk to your equipment attached to methodology
  - 3.6.1. In terms of the appointment, three service providers will have one competent person on a 12-month basis for two minor services in 10 months.

3.6.2. Are all these services required in this area?

TASEZ Answer: Yes, TASEZ have phase 1 and Phase 1A and the other phases which will be implemented which is 2 and 3, the scope will be extended.
